We will meet at approximately 9:45 am just beyond the main entry (let's not block the entry) or whenever you can arrive (if you are arriving after the 9:45 am meeting time, just look for other Pack members in our yellow scout shirts or call someone from 'the list' – see rspv information for 'the list')

COST: \$20 / vehicle, no cost for admission

NEEDED: CLASS B's (yellow t-shirt and Scout ball cap)
